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

PURPOSE: (CFRD) Request the Chairman, NWC approve the replacement of the B53 with a modified B61-7 delivered by the B-2 by signing the vote sheet at Tab 1. Also, request the Chairman inform the appropriate Congressional leaders of the NWC decision as soon as possible. The Congressional contacts and unclassified talking points are at Tab 2: classified details on the B53 replacement project which supplement the talking points are contained below in the DISCUSSION paragraphs.

DISCUSSION: (CFRD) On January 18, 1995 the NWCSSC members unanimously concurred to request the NWC approve a project to replace the B53 with a modified B61-7 delivered by the B-2. The request for NWC approval, Action Item NWC 95-01 "Replacement of the B53 Strategic Gravity Bomb" is at Tab 3. The following statements summarize the action item:

(SFRD) To minimize cost and schedule impacts vis-à-vis B-2 integration, the modified B61-7 and stockpiled B61-7 must have the same aerodynamic and ballistic properties and the same electrical and software interfaces with the B-2. An acceptable conceptual design for a modified B61-7 has been developed.

(CFRD) After NWC approval to replace the B53, DoD and DOE will consult with staff members of the HNSC and SASC and the Defense/National Security and Energy and Water Subcommittees of the HAC and SAC. These consultations must precede transmittal of the NWC Annual Report to Congress scheduled for mid-February because the report reflects the DoD and DOE intent to proceed with the B53 replacement. Following Congressional receipt of the report, the AF and DOE will send Congress letters of notification delineating funding sources. The ATSD(AE) will then request the AF and DOE to implement a B53 replacement project under the direction of the B61 Project Officers Group.

COORDINATION: (U) Mr. Curtis' and Admiral Owens' approvals of the action item, NWC 195-01 "Replacement of the B53 Strategic Gravity Bomb", are at Tab 4.

RECOMMENDATION: (CFRD) Chairman, NWC approve replacement of the B53 by a modified B61-7 delivered by the B-2 by signing the vote sheet at Tab 1. Subsequently, and as soon as possible, Chairman, NWC inform the Chairmen and Ranking Minority Members of the SAC Defense Subcommittee and the HAC National Security Subcommittee of the NWC decision to replace the B53 with a modified B61-7.

UNCLASSIFIED TALKING POINTS:

- My purpose in contacting you today is to inform you of the Nuclear Weapons Council's decision to replace the B53 strategic gravity bomb with a modified version of an existing stockpiled weapon and the importance the Council places on this project-replacement of the B53 will improve the overall safety posture of the nation's nuclear weapons stockpile.
- In the next few days, a small group of experts from the Departments of Defense and Energy will meet with your staff members to explain the details of the B53 replacement project.
- We believe that this work can be accomplished without seeking additional resources from Congress by capitalizing on previous work that was developed for another program, coupled with minor reprogramming actions that will follow normal committee reporting procedures.
- This replacement project will not require a nuclear test.

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SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

FOR

NWC ACTION ITEM 95-01 "REPLACEMENT OF THE B53 STRATEGIC GRAVITY BOMB" (U)

(S) The modified B61-7, the replacement for the B53, will be delivered by the B-2 bomber. To minimize the cost for B-2 integration and the time to initial operational capability, the modified B61-7 must satisfy the following requirement:

the modified B61-7 and stockpiled B61-7 must have the same aerodynamic and ballistic properties and the same electrical and software interfaces with the B-2.

An acceptable conceptual design for a modified B61-7 has been developed

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- (S) After Council approval of the replacement of the B53, the following steps will be taken in the order shown below:
 - (1) DoD and DOE will consult with the majority and minority Professional Staff Members of the House and Senate Appropriations Defense Subcommittees, the Senate Armed Services Committee, the House National Security Committee, and the House and Senate Energy and Water Subcommittees. Professional Staff Members will be apprised of the Council's decision to replace the B53 with a modified B61-7, in support of the President's decision (PDD/NSC-30) to enhance the safety of the nation's nuclear weapons stockpile.
 - (2) Consultations with the Professional Staff Members will precede transmittal of the NWC Annual Report to Congress, February 6, 1995. The Report reflects the DoD/DOE intent to proceed with replacement of the B53.
 - (3) AF and DOE will send letters of notification to Congress delineating funding sources.
 - (4) The ATSD(AE) will request the AF and the DOE to implement a B53 replacement project under the aegis of the B61 Project Officers Group.

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
