5. (U) ACC has the full support of Air Staff XO (see Tab 3) who is pushing forward with a similar proposal through the Director, Joint Staff. The Air Staff XO memo to the DJS was coordinated through ACC/DO.

6. (S) The proposed ACC/DO message commits ACC to reassigning DCA readiness levels. Joint Staff is likely to make aircraft type a contingency of reduced readiness requirements if ACC does not commit to transferring the taskings.
