

- NAVAL SHIPS IMPACTED PROLIFERATION?-GROUP, NO WALLERSTEIN: HAS REMOVAL OF NUCS FROM KOREA/OFF
- PROBLEM IN PERCEPTION OF ADVERSARY. ALTFELD: FORWARD DEPLOYED WEAPONS PROVIDE TRIGGER MECHANISM; NON-DEPLOYED PRESENT TIME LINES

- SUBSET OF LARGER PROBLEM. MR STEPHENS: TERRORISTS WILL NOT DRIVE FORCE POSTURE.

CONTRIBUTORS (CONT):

DISCUSSION ON DEEPLY BURIED FACILITIES

SIGNIFICANT OUTCOMES:

- GROUP AGREED PROBABLY BAD IDEA TO EXPAND NSA TO INCLUDE CHEM/BIO & LEGALIZE UNDER NPT
- GROUP CONSENSUS THAT NUCLEAR WEAPONS TYPES OF TARGETS REMAIN THE ONLY METHOD OF DESTROYING CERTAIN
