2. We have reviewed the briefing slides provided with the referenced note and provide the following comments thereon:

DETERRING THE ACQUISITION OF WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION

Slide 11 We recommend that the slide or briefing state that it is the view of the United States that mere NPT non-nuclear participation is not dispositive. Violation of the Treaty by the acquisition of nuclear weapons voids the NSA.

Slide 12 We recommend that slide not use phrase "some say it is too soon to give up conditions". It seems to be the general military consensus that conditional pledge is all that is wise.
