THE TEXT OF THE GENSCHER LETTER FOLLOWS, IN AN INFORMAL EMBASSY TRANSLATION. BEGIN TEXT:

THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN FOLLOWING WITH CONCERN THE DISCUSSIONS ON THE MOST RECENT DECISION OF THE DANISH PARLIAMENT ON SECURITY POLICY. THE NATO SUMMET IN BRUSSELT OIL MARCH 2 AND 3 EMPHATICALLY REAFFIRMED THE SUCCESSFUL SECURITY POLICY OF THE ALLIANCE. POLITICAL SOLIDARITY AND ADEQUATE MILITARY STRENGTH, ARMS CONTROL AND DISARMAMENT, AS WELL AS EFFORTS TO PROHOTE EAST-MEST DIALOGUE AND COOPERATION ARE INTEGRAL BASTS OF THES POLICY. WE JOINTLY AGREED IN BRUSSELS THAT THE SECURITY OF THE EUROPEAN AND NORTH AMERICAN PARTNERS ARE INSOLUBLY BOUND UP WITH EACH OTHER, AND THAT THE PRESENCE OF US CONVENTIONAL AND NUCLEAR FORCES IN EUROPE CONSTITUTES THE ESSENTIAL LINK TO THE US STRATEGIC DETERRENT. IT REMAINS OUR HIGHEST PRIGRITY TO DETER ANY KIND OF WAR. THERE IS NO ALTERNATIVE IN THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE TO THIS STRATEGY
