6. ALSO, FOR THE PURPOSES OF GOAL ONE, NEW HOULD PLACE LESS EMPHASIS ON THE MARCH SUMMIT'S UNANIMETY IN SUPPORT OF PRIOR TO THE SHIP VISIT CRISIS, THE NUCLEAR DETERMENT. THE DANISH GOVERNMENT WAS ALREADY IN A DEFENSIVE HODE AGAINST SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC CHARGES THATE THE SUMMIT DECLARATION WAS IN CONFLICT WITH AN EARLIER PARLIAMENTARY IT SEEMS TO US . HAT OUR EMPHASIS SHOULD BE RESOLUTION. ON NATO SOLIDARITY IN A BROAD SENSE, STRESSING THE BENEFITS OF COLLECTIVE SECURITY AND THE FACT THAT THESE BENEFITS ENTAIL MUTAL DBLIGATIONS. THIS IS THE POINT WHICH PRIME MINISTER SCHLUETER HAS BEEN MAKING PUBLICLY AND IT WILL BE HELPFUL TO REINFORCE THE IDEA THAT FAILURE TO MEET THE OBLIGATIONS COMMONLY AGREED TO RUNS THE RISK OF LOSING THE BENEFITS.
