"THE DANISH PARLIAMENT DIRECTS THE GOVERNMENT TO INFORM  
THE GOVERNMENTS OF OUR NATO ALLIES ABOUT THE NUCLEAR  
POLICY, WHICH HAS BEEN IN EFFECT DURING THE PAST 30  
YEARS, AND ACCORDING TO WHICH DANISH TERRITORY --  
INCLUDING PORTS -- IS NUCLEAR-FREE IN TIMES OF PEACE,  
AND TO ASK THE GOVERNMENTS TO INSTRUCT THEIR CAPTAINS ON  
VISITING NAVAL VESSELS ABOUT THIS POLICY."

WORKING ON THIS PROBLEM IN CASE WE ARE SOON

FOR MAY 18, NO IMMEDIATE ACTION IS CALLED FOR ON  
MY REFTEL RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING THE PROBLEM  
CREATED BY THE PARLIAMENT'S RESOLUTION ON SHIP  
VISITS. HOWEVER, SINCE WE UNDERSTAND THE RESOLUTION  
REMAINS ON THE BOOKS, THERE IS NO DOUBT THAT WE  
WILL FACE THE ISSUE AGAIN WHEN THE PARLIAMENT  
CONVENES AFTER THE ELECTION, AND IT IS THEREFORE  
IMPORTANT THAT WE CONTINUE TO LOOK FOR A SOLUTION  
WE CAN LIVE WITH.
