MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN, JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF

Subject: Renaming the Single Integrated Operational Plan (SIOP)

Given the significant changes introduced by recent quidance, and the definitive departure from Cold War thinking signalled therein, I have decided to rename the SIOP. This document is evolving to a collection of far more differentiated retaliatory choices, tailored to a threat environment of greater nuance and complexity. Therefore, in future correspondence we will use the title, "National Strategic Response Plans," to refer to this diverse family of options. The title, "SIOP-93," will be retained until the impending major revision is completed over the next several months.
