Subject: NSNF Working Group Meeting Minutes of 10 May 94

1. (U) The NSNF Working Group met at 1330, 10 May 94. The following personnel were present:

2. (U) The following topics were discussed:

23) a (b) CDR debriefed minutes of the last meeting. The minutes were approved.

b. (U) CDR debriefed the visit to USEUCOM. STRATCOM reps met with staff officers from EUCOM J-3 and J-5 on 2-4 May 94. Lt Col Colombia Staff J-36/NOB also participated in the discussions. This memo constitutes the trip report for the visit.

(1) (U) A series of briefings were given by the EUCOM staff. EUCOM's roles and missions, EUCOM's Nuclear Weapons Requirements and EUCOM's Theater Missile Defense Initiative. STRATCOM staff gave briefings on the Theater Nuclear Support Model and Counterproliferation Initiatives.


(3) (U) The following issues were addressed:

(a) (U) CINCEUR's position regarding firebreak policy associated with EUCOM support of CINCCENT's nuclear mission. (i.e., USCINCEUR intends to retain all functions related to nuclear mission execution, including firebreak of Presidential direction, for missions staged within his theater).

(b) (U) CINCEUR's position regarding overflight and staging support assumptions contained in USSTRATCOM's support plan. (i.e., all plans should recognize that overflight and staging support may not be available).

(c) (U) Use of command and control aircraft staged out of EUCOM's AOR in support of CINCCENT's nuclear mission.

(d) (U) Commonalty of command and control procedures in inter-theater nuclear operations, including common SAS/PAL usage.



(5) (U) EUCOM staff expressed concern regarding staging and overflight assumptions contained in the USSTRATCOM support plan. EUCOM staff recommended the assumption be modified to include "subject to agreement of the host nation ..." Agreement was reached to modify the support plan accordingly.

(7) (U) It was agreed that centralized PAL management discussed in the Theater Nuclear support model could be implemented in the short-term with the exchange of PAL materials between STRATCOM and EUCOM (for missions not executed from CINCEUR's AOR using CINCEUR delivery platforms/weapons).

(10) (U) The draft nuclear support annex to OPLAN 4122 is ready for internal coordination.
